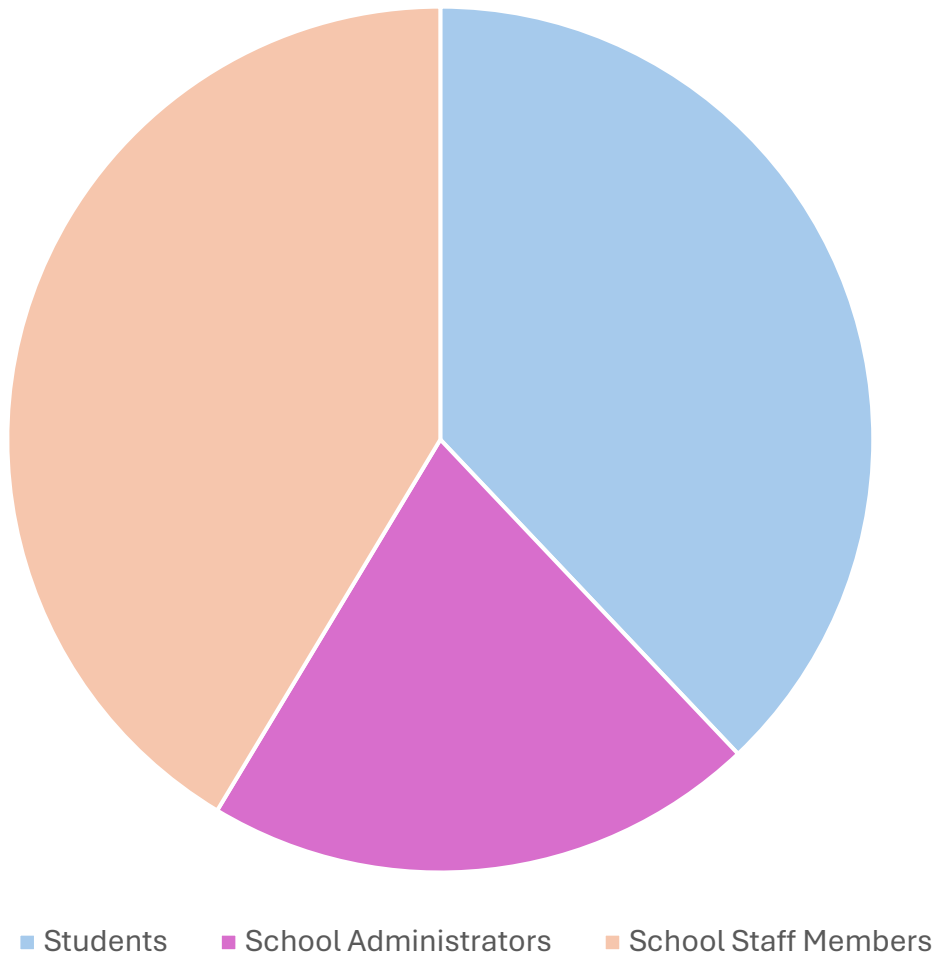


Mental Health Statistics



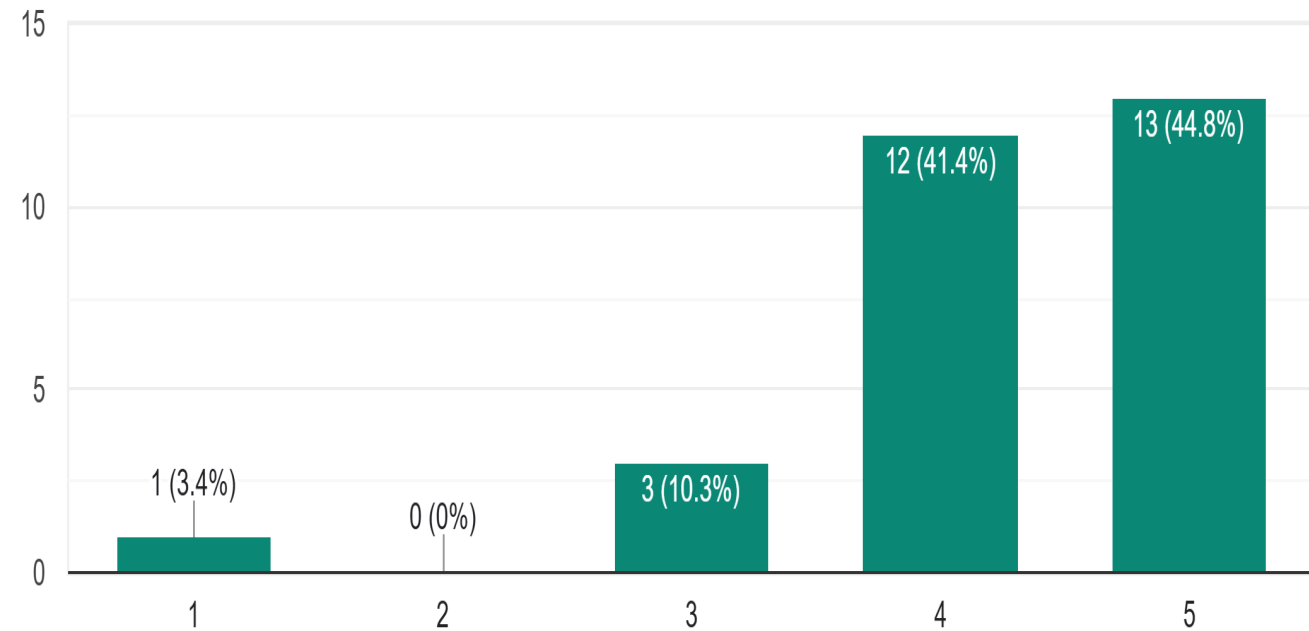
