

Governance/Charter

- Separate Commission members for Parking Place and Traffic Safety Commission
- Develop a Parking Master Plan for SSF
 - Future parking needs?
 - Bike Storage with BPAC
- Any development/projects that involves or impacts parking in parking district should require PPC review/approval
- Any addition or removal of parking (spaces, garage, etc) should require approval of PPC

Parking District Fund/Finance

- PPC should be involved with the annual budgeting process of the Parking District Fund. PPC should provide endorsement/approval before presenting it to Council for final approval
- Involved with LRP and Capital Improvement Plan
- PPC should oversee and full supervision authority on the Parking District Fund
 - PPC should have complete oversight and should bear responsibility for the district fund.
- Parking citation revenue should roll back into the Parking District Fund and all related expenses for Parking Enforcement should come out of the Parking District Fund

Parking garage #2 funding was \$1.1M and was removed from Parking District Fund for that expenditure

The Planning Commission reviews the CIP prior to the City Council and makes a recommendation whether it is or is not consistent with the General Plan.
