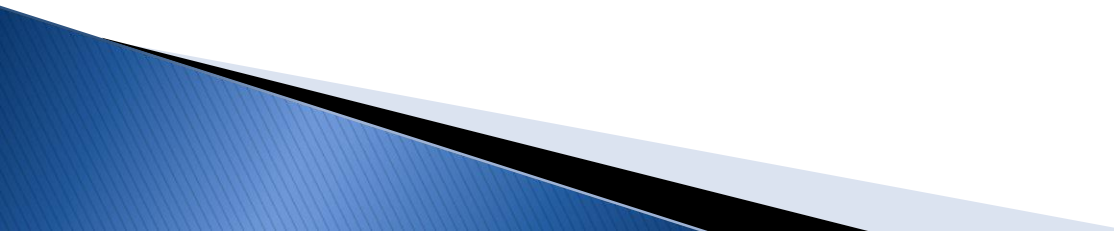

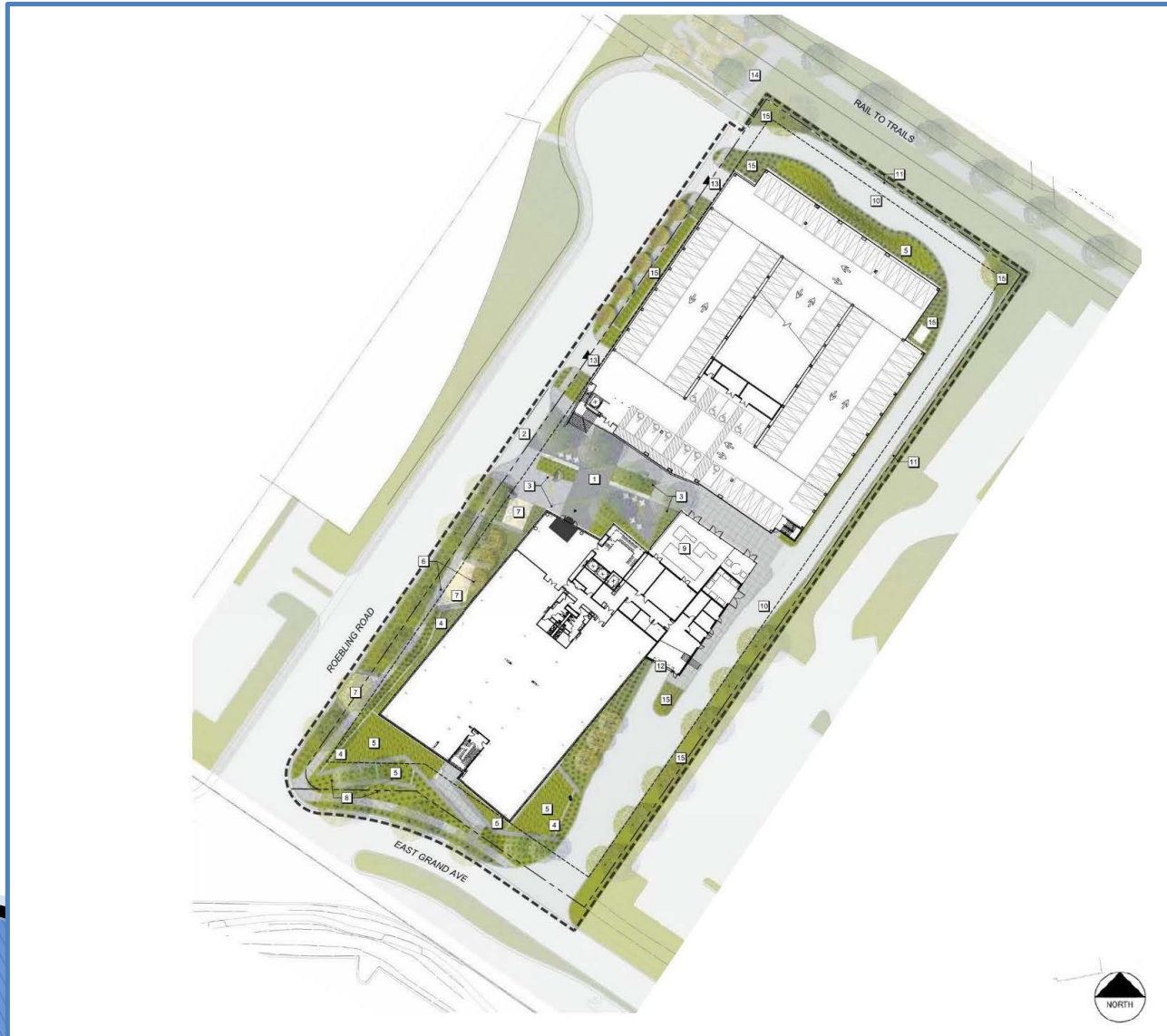

# First Amendment to the DA


- Update to the Project Description to reflect the Revised Project
- Updated fees to include Commercial Linkage Fee and Bicycle and Pedestrian Impact Fee for the ~25,000 sf of additional building area
- Agreement to participate in a Community Facilities District, if formed, at an annual tax rate equivalent to \$1 /gsf or such annual tax rate that applies to similar Life Sciences projects in East of 101



# Environmental Review

- City Council certified the 2012 Recirculated IS/MND on November 14, 2012
    - Included Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program
  - 2020 Addendum prepared for revised project
    - Design Review Modification remains consistent with the previous document, continues to be subject to IS/MND and Addendum
  - No further environmental analysis required
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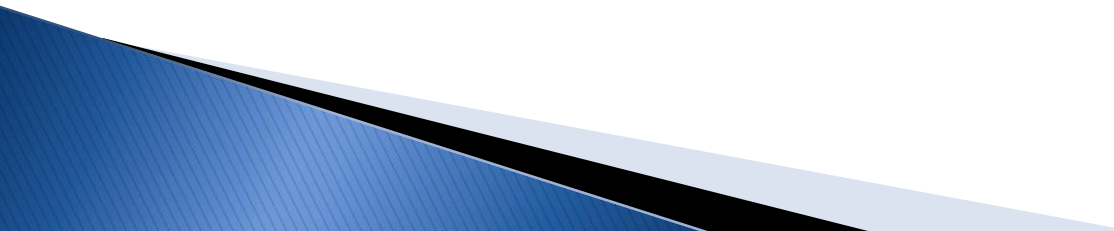
# Planning Commission

- Reviewed on June 4, 2020
  - Questions related to:
    - Traffic impact on East Grand Ave
    - Development Agreement Requirements
    - Wind Attenuation
    - Storm Water Retention
    - Business Trends due to pandemic
  - Recommended approval by vote of 7–0
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# Recommendation

That the City Council follow the Planning Commission's recommendation and take the following actions:

1. Adopt a Resolution making findings and determining that the 2020 Addendum is the appropriate environmental document, and
  2. Waive reading and introduce an Ordinance approving the First Amendment to the Development Agreement; and,
  3. Adopt a Resolution approving the Design Review Modification, subject to the draft conditions of approval.
