

RECOGNITION OF APRIL AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH

WHEREAS, Adequate housing is a basic need and right of all people; and

WHEREAS, this year we celebrate the 58th Anniversary of the enactment of the Federal Fair Housing Act of 1968 (Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act), which states that discrimination in the sale and rental of housing is illegal when based on race, color, religion, sex, or national origin; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 extends fair housing rights on the basis of familial status to families with children, and on the basis of handicap to disabled persons; and

WHEREAS, California statutes additionally protect citizens on the basis of age, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity and source of income; and California celebrates the 66th Anniversary of the Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA); and

WHEREAS, the City of South San Francisco supports fair housing efforts to eliminate discrimination in housing and recognizes the benefits of Project Sentinel to educate home seekers, apartment managers, and apartment owners on federal and state housing laws, and to investigate complaints of illegal housing discrimination in South San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, in order to heighten public awareness, the City of South San Francisco wishes to focus public attention on April as Fair Housing Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, *that the City Council of the City of South San Francisco does hereby proclaim April 2026 as “FAIR HOUSING MONTH,” and do encourage all residents and community organizations to celebrate the value of harmonious and diverse communities of neighbors and to support the goal of equal housing opportunity for all people.*
