

New Park at Linden & Pine - Overview


The project includes three distinct but coordinated mosaic art components designed to work in harmony:

- 1. Mosaic Columns at Plaza
- 2. Mosaic Inlays at Plaza
- 3. Playground Mosaic Sculpture.

The goal is for a single artist or artist team to develop all three to create a cohesive visual and conceptual language throughout the site.


New Park at Linden & Pine – Artist Selection Criteria

- Relevant Experience (20 points)
- Technical Capability (15 points)
- Community Engagement Approach (15 points)
- Professionalism & Collaboration (10 points)
- Local/Regional Connection (5 points)


