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Detailed Description of Complaint/Request. Include Specific Location and/or Sketches to Describe Problem (Use Additional Sheets if Necessary):

The speed limit for westbound Arroyo is posted as 25 mph and is posted in 2 locations. Eastbound Arroyo does not have any signs that state the speed limit.

There are parts of eastbound Arroyo that have a slope decline of over 30°, but there is no signage to inform drivers of cars and buses of the speed limit.

Dog walkers and pedestrians have to cross Arroyo with vehicles driving at over 35mph, especially during commute times and at the beginning or ending of schools sessions.


Desired Recommendations To Address Complaint/Request (Use Additional Sheets if Necessary):

I recommend, at minimum, that speed limit signs be posted for eastbound Arroyo drivers, at Alta Mesa Drive where vehicles enter onto Arroyo from Junipero Serra Drive, at Capay Circle, where the excessive down slope begins, and at Cuesta Drive to remind drivers to slow down nearing the crosswalk in front of Buri Buri Park.

Positioning a speed radar display be posted at Verano Drive may help remind drivers to slow down.






