Make the map available for public review and comment within 30 days.





# What are FHSZ Maps?

- Created by CALFIRE under the direction of the State Fire Marshal
- Local jurisdictions are required to review and adopt the updated maps, ensuring communities are better prepared for wildfire threats.
- Land Use Planning Maps that reflect a "hazard" classification with respect to wildfire





#### Fire Hazard Severity Zones — Classifications

#### What are the FHSZ Classifications?


- All lands within a FHSZ are classified by one of three (3) ways:
  - Moderate Yellow
  - High Orange
  - Very High Red
- The updated maps are based on a science-driven and fieldtested model that evaluates multiple factors influencing fire likelihood and behavior


