The interest of the City is served best by actual and regular participation by Board and Commission members. Thus, upon the second absence from a regular meeting within any rolling twelve-month period, a member shall receive a written communication from the Mayor requesting that the member respond to the Mayor with an explanation for said absences within one week of the member's receipt of the written communication. The Mayor shall report to the City Council the reasons provided for the member's absences. If the City Council determines that the absences occurred for legitimate reasons, the City Council may excuse both or one of the absences. Members are also encouraged to give advanced notice of their absence from meetings.

**What qualifies you for this position?**

I have lived in South San Francisco for more than twenty-five years and have many fond childhood memories thanks to the South City Park and Recreation department. My father taught me to swim at the Orange Memorial Pool and I learned to play tennis at the court in Brentwood Park. I have taken many classes offered through the SSF Park and Recreation's Activity Guide over the years. In recent years, I can be found cycling through South City's parks and bike paths on weekends. My dog loves the Centennial Way Dog Park and we visit Brentwood Park every day.

In 1996, I became an Eagle Scout and my community project was to restore and landscape the area surrounding the Bocce Ball Courts in Orange Avenue Park. The project took several days to complete with about twenty volunteers.

I am a recent graduate of the University of California, Master Gardener's program. For my final project, I restored an area surrounding the San Carlos Library, installed an irrigation system and planted drought resistant, pollinator-friendly and native plants. In an ongoing agreement with between the UC Master Gardener Program and the City of San Carlos, the city will provide ongoing financial support for necessary plants and supplies and Master Gardeners will volunteer their time to maintain the area. It is my hope that this partnership will serve as a model between the UC Master Gardener program and other cities, including South San Francisco.
