PHS/SPCA Programs – For Shelter Animals

- Adoption Program (Shelter Animals)
 - All kinds of domestic animals come through our doors – dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters, mice, snakes, bearded dragons, iguanas, chickens, doves, pigeons... the list goes on
 - They receive medical and behavioral care for their entire time with us
 - In 2024, we found 3,105 animals their furever homes
- Kitten Nursey (Shelter Animals)
 - Seasonal and cares for over 600 cats from April-September

PHS/SPCA Programs – For the Public

- Dog Training Classes
 - Puppy play groups, group training lessons
 - One-on-one consultations and training
- Education Programs
 - Summer camp, vet shadow program, scout compassion program, classroom presentations
- Pet Assisted Therapy
 - Therapy animals visiting hospitals, schools, events, and more
- Pet Food Bank
 - For San Mateo county pet owners who need assistance
