 - Materials in English and Spanish

Applications and Evaluation


- Six (6) Applications Received

Selected Tenant – Six Bicycles



- Owned by Christopher Nguyen
- Full-service bicycle shop: repairs, tune-ups, rentals, sales
- Offers group rides & maintenance workshops
- Supports active transportation and community engagement
- Ideal location near SSF High School and Centennial Way Trail

Move-In	Keys by end of 2025; Grand Opening Spring 2026

Fiscal Impact



- Lease Revenue: < \$19,200 (12 months)
- Up to \$10,000 TI Rent Credit
- Minor maintenance funded through reserve funds
- No General Fund Impact

- Grand Opening: Spring 2026
