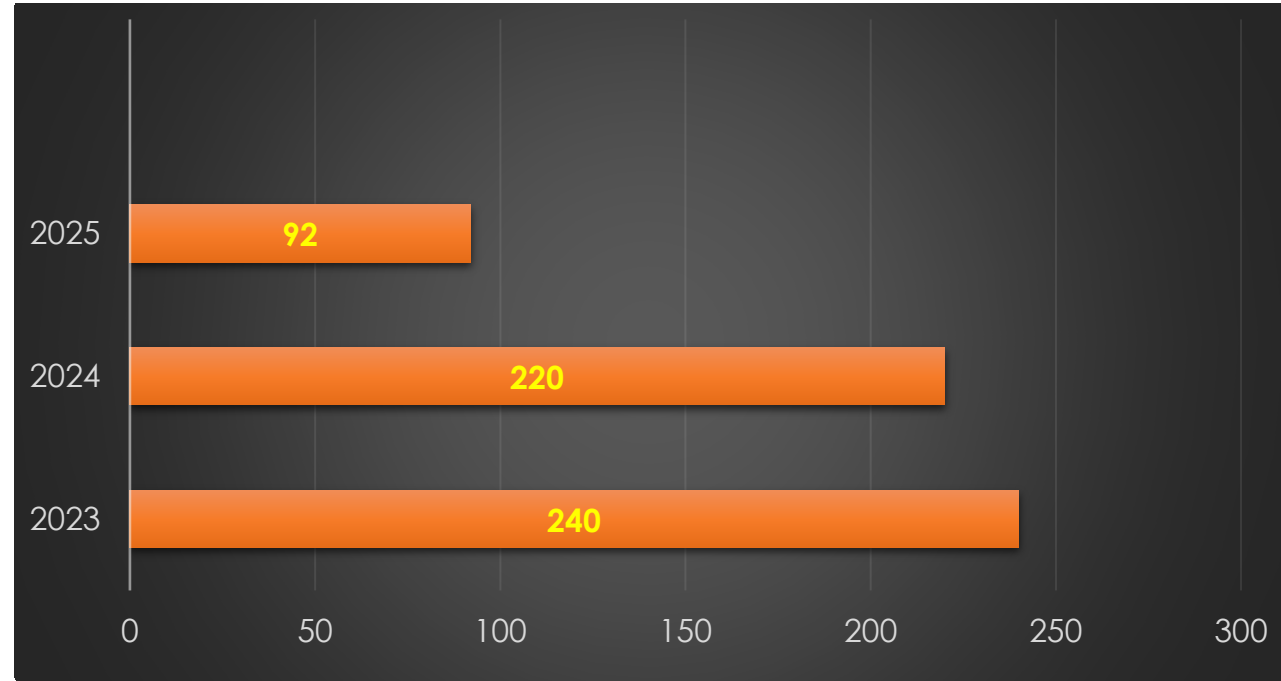

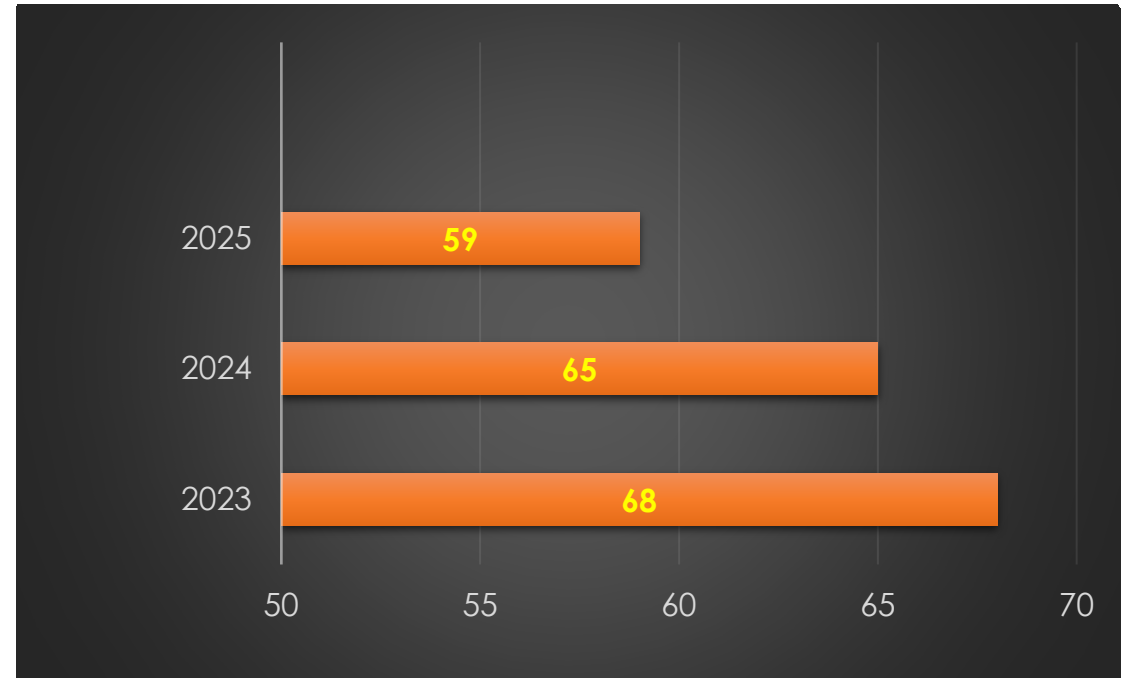

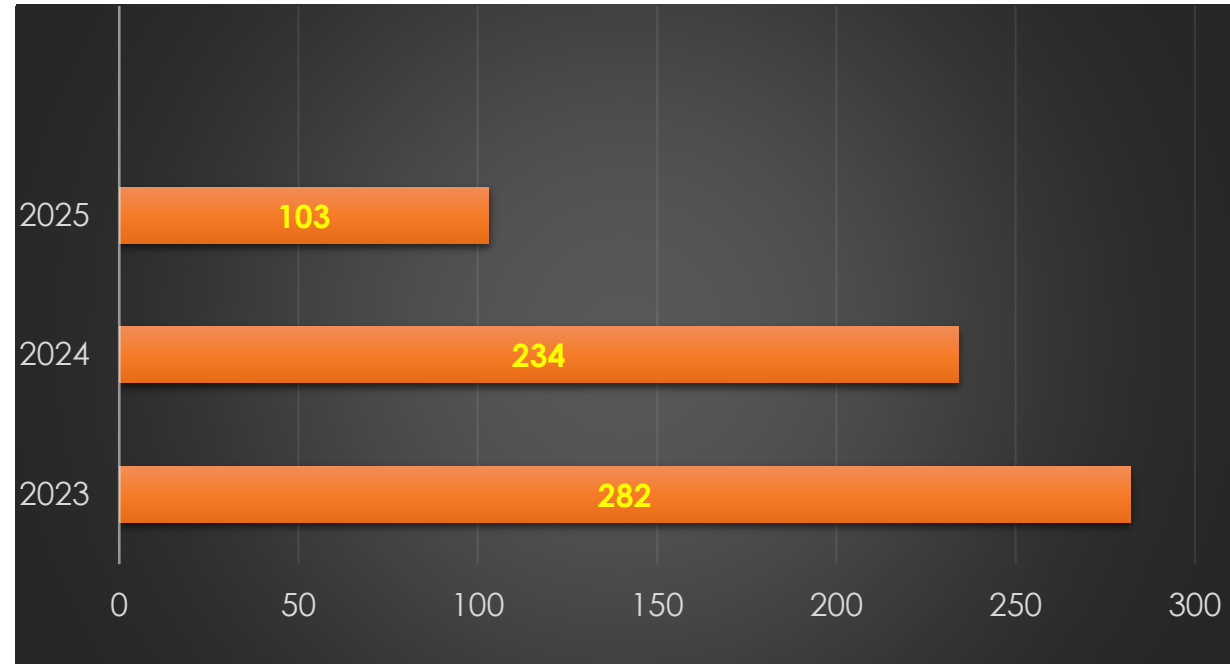

Commercial Burglary



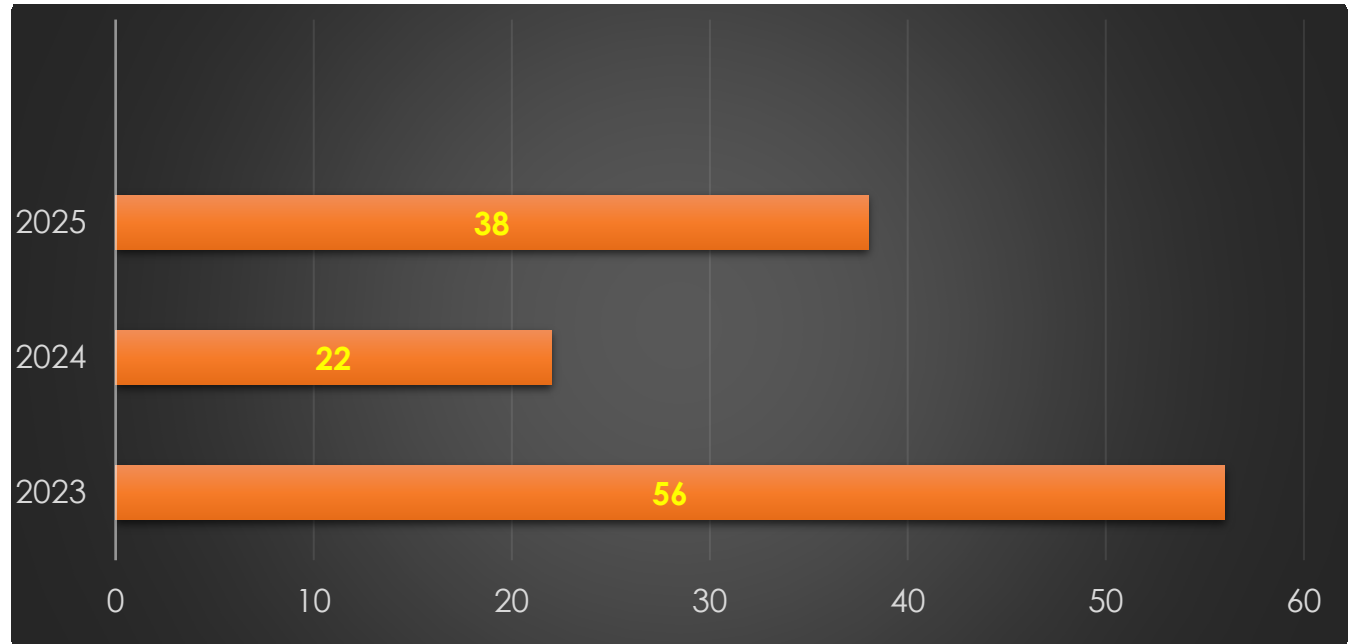

Vehicle Burglary



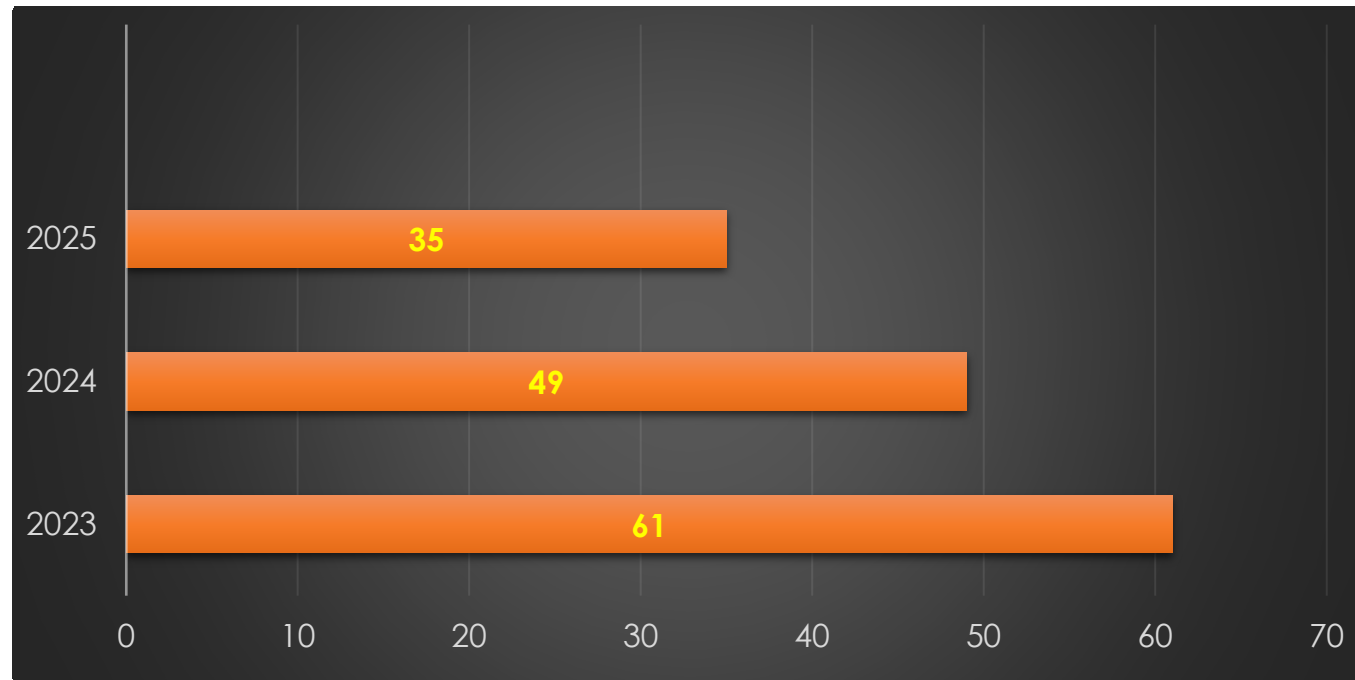

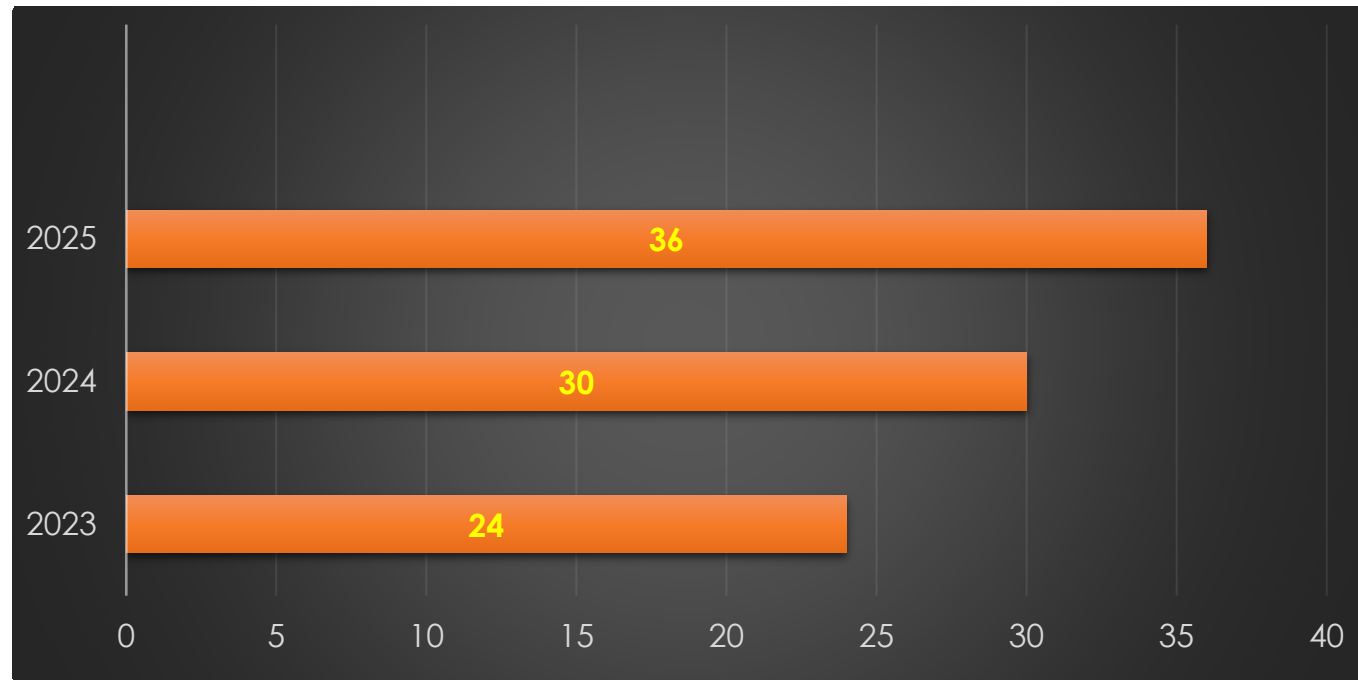

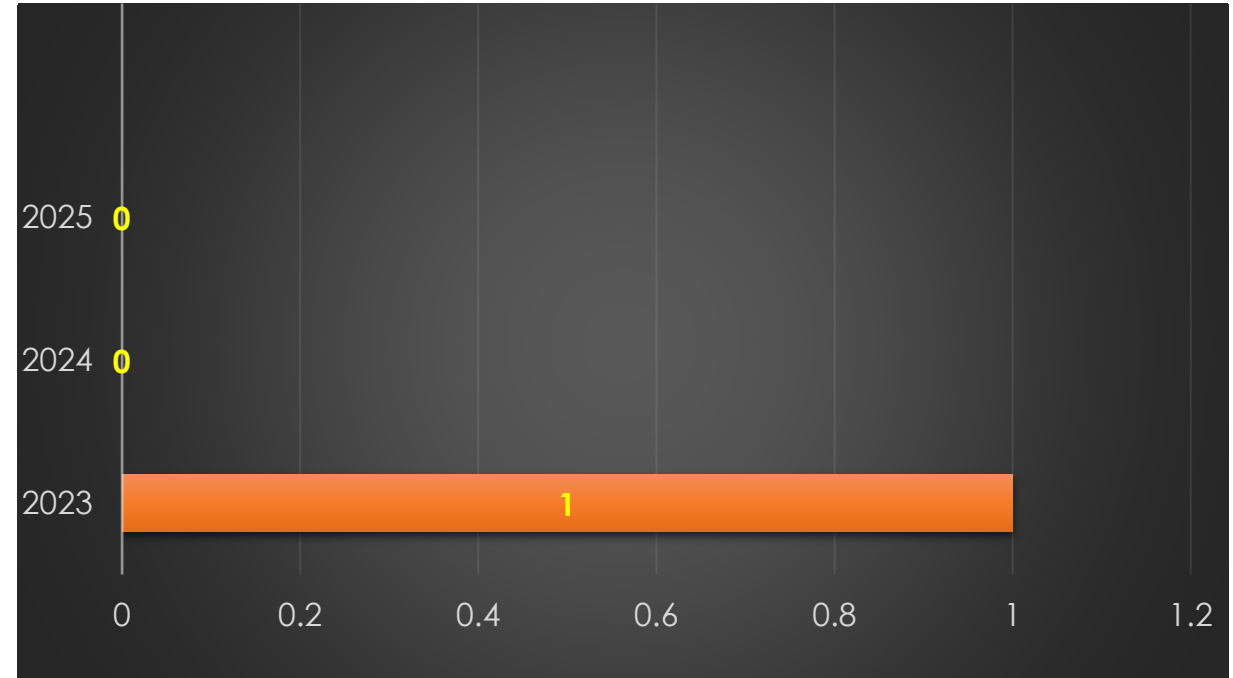

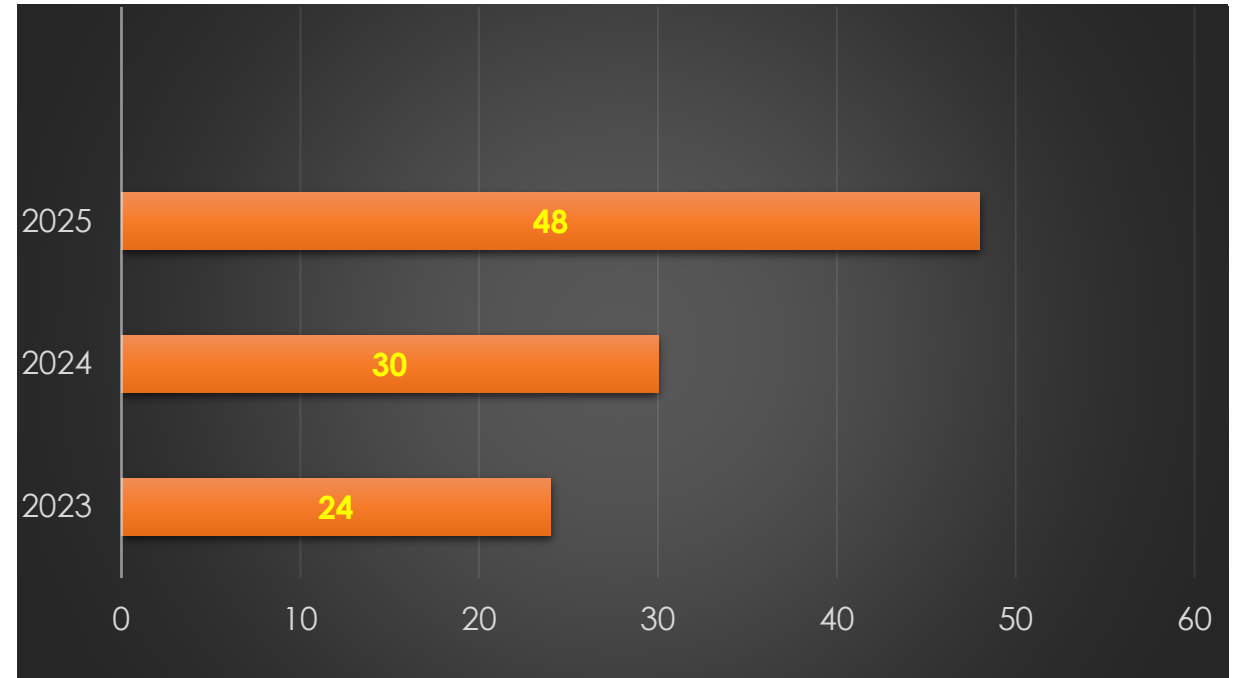

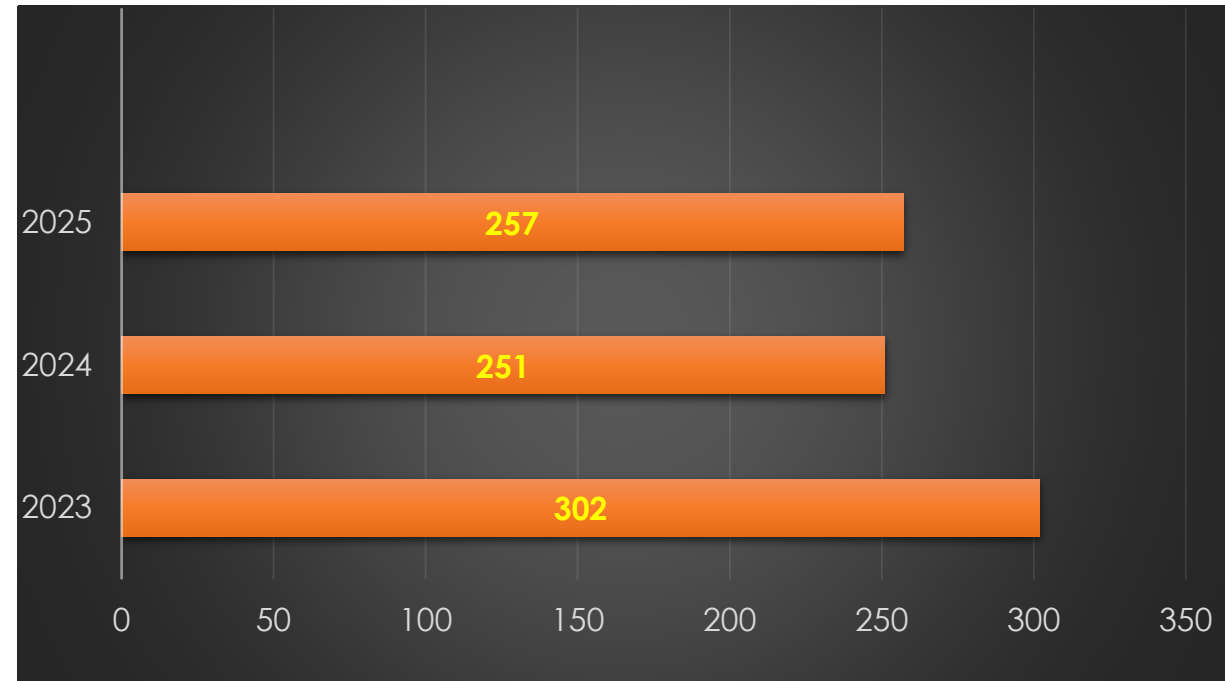
Illegally Possessed Firearms Seized

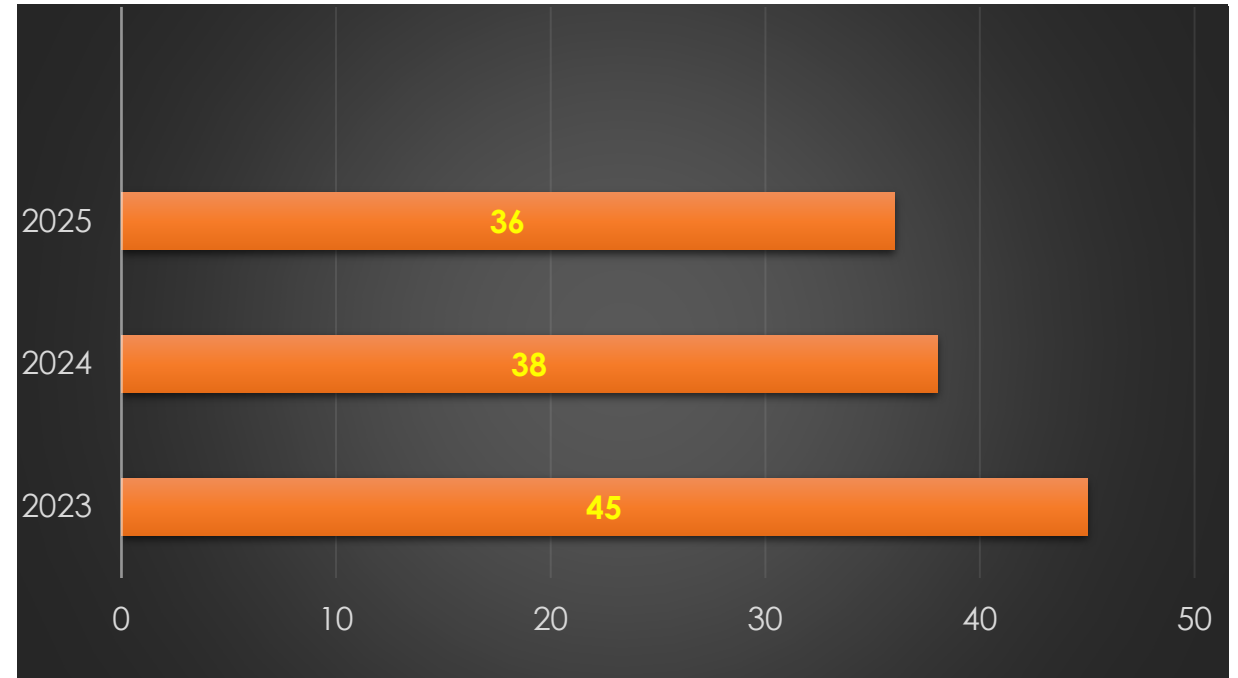
