



# About the *Dronesites*

## What?

*Implementing Safety drones at the discussed drone sites around the SSF area.*

## How?

*Request for increase in Community Safety budget to finance safety drones. Drones would specifically be designated around schools and high risk areas.*

## Whom?

*We will be targeting areas around the neighborhood in South San Francisco and even parks. Then, drones will add extra security around our Elementary, Middle, and High around South San Francisco in case of emergencies, the drones would be able to assist and assess the situation and transmit all information to first responders.*

# *Why are we here?*

## Needs ✦

***The expansion of the current drone program for First Responders, which would include site locations in the Westborough area. More available drones means more availability, a wider and longer range of sites that can be monitored, and expansion of our safety responses.***

## Benefit ✦

*The first DFR drone will have 258 flights, with an average of two flights a day. The DFR drones arrived at the scene first 65% of the time and cleared almost 13% of call services without an officer responding. There was more coverage and faster responses when using DFR drones.*


# financial statement

## Phase 01

*The initial estimated fiscal impact for installation and infrastructure is approximately \$15,000 from the new drone project, but it may be less if we consider it with the building of the new project.*

## Phase 02

*If approved by the City Council, it would authorize the use of \$205,805.35 of Public Safety Impact Fees and \$60,861.35 of the Police Operating Budget which will span over a 5-year contract.*





# *Relation to strategic plan*

1. They can be assisted with searching for people and documenting scenes and responding to major incidents.
2. Drone sends live video to help first responders understand the situation before they arrive.
3. and it will also help to expand the program for the use of the Drone program and to help the First Responder to seek and send a patrol officer later than 5-10 mins

The expansion of the DFR drones will offer safer protection for the community and faster response time for our Police departments and first responders.
