3. Commissioners will hear an update from the Communications Ad Hoc Committee (Commissioners Harrison, Rodriguez, and Yee)

The Ad Hoc Committee has met twice and identified three primary focus areas: (1) leveraging community representatives to bring diverse voices and perspectives forward; (2) understanding how community members are currently receiving information; and (3) improving the accessibility and inclusivity of City communications.

The Committee concentrated its discussion on how information is being received by the public. The next step is to obtain and review relevant data to better inform future recommendations. Additional discussion included hosting prominent community leaders at future commission meetings once relationships have been established.

4. Commissioners will review the slide deck presentation to City Council (Devin Stenhouse, Management Analyst II)

Commissioners and Management Analyst II, Devin Stenhouse, reviewed the presentation and discussed edits to refine the content. The Commission engaged in briefings and discussions regarding presentations to the Commission and topics under review. The Commissioners examined the slides that were created and discussed how the information would be presented to the City Council. Devin Stenhouse notified the Commission of next steps and timelines related to the presentation.
