My most direct work commute route from South Westborough to East Grand Ave (101) bypasses this ECR stretch, but since learning of the installation, I've extended my morning commute a few times to include this span to get a better sense of what this could mean for expansion to other stretches of ECR. That said, I'm just providing my initial impressions:

- 1. The intermittent posts provide a nice physical separation for bikes without disrupting cars from entering/leaving businesses.
- 2. The posts also allow for riders to move over to the left turn lane on Spruce when it is clear, but for less experienced commuters, probably best to ride down to ECR/Spruce, dismount, and walk bike across ECR. Left turn lane (SB El Camino) at Spruce gets backed up, leading to drivers merging to middle/right lanes abruptly at times.
- 3. Bus ramp at Country Club drive is an effective way to reduce bus and car traffic for bicyclists (not having to merge into traffic to avoid bus in shoulder)
- 4. As mentioned previously, this stretch of ECR is not in my usual commute route, so I can't speak to the impact before/after installation. However,I would support thoughtful implementation of safety measures for bicyclists to promote or encourage others to use it (bikes) as an alternate, viable means of transportation where possible.
