Draft Legislative Platform

Legislative policies are organized by City Council Priorities Action Plan – Major Focus Areas.

1. Housing and Supportive Services. Promote housing stability, affordability, and access to supportive services that meet the needs of South San Francisco's diverse community.

2. Infrastructure and the Environment. Invest in resilient, sustainable infrastructure and protect environmental quality to support long-term community and environmental health and economic vitality.

3. Modern and Sustainable Organization. Ensure a fiscally responsible, innovative, and high-performing City organization that can effectively serve the community.

4. Quality of Life. Enhance public safety, community well-being, and access to essential services that contribute to a high quality of life.

5. Welcoming and Connected Community. Foster an inclusive, engaged, and connected community that reflects South San Francisco's diversity and values.



Draft Legislative Platform

Implementation Section

- Mayor and City Manager, or authorized designee, may approve legislative positions consistent with the platform
- Possible advocacy strategies
- Formal position letters
 - Can be signed by City Manager, or authorized designee
 - When requested, letters will be submitted within two weeks
- Individual Councilmember advocacy
