### What is a Specific Plan?

#### What is it?

- A comprehensive planning and zoning tool for a small area
- Refines the vision and guiding principles
- Defines policy and development standards
- Strong focus on implementation

#### What's Required?

- Distribution, location, and extent of the uses of land, including open space
- Proposed distribution, location, and extent and intensity of major components of transportation and infrastructure
- Development standards
- A program of implementation measures
- A statement of the relationship of the specific plan to the general plan



# Mobility Goals and Policies




GOAL 1: Multi-modal travel options are readily available and offer equal levels of comfort.

#### Policies:

- implement layered network approach
- prioritize safety over speed and vehicle flow
- plan for flexibility and future trends

## Mobility Goals and Policies



MOB GOAL-2: There are high-quality connections to Downtown, El Camino, East of 101, and regional destinations for all modes.

#### Policies:

- buildout connections for vehicles at El Camino Real and San Mateo Avenue gateways
- buildout connections for bicycles and pedestrians at Spruce, Colma Creek, and new cross-town trail gateways
- protect and establish new high-quality transit service between Lindenville and the Caltrain and BART stations

## Mobility Goals and Policies



MOB GOAL-3: Lindenville's transportation offerings and streetscape design support a vibrant mixed-use district.


#### Policies:

- apply parking code and TDM requirements
- break up big blocks with new streets and alleys
- prioritize bike/ped access in new development design
- facilitate safe truck activity
- incorporate stormwater management into streetscape projects

### Specific Plan Mobility Network

### **Bicycle Network**

- More access points to Centennial Trail
- New cycle-track on S. Spruce
- Extension of trail along Colma Creek
- New cross-town trail connecting Centennial and Bay Trail
- Many local access routes



### **Cross Town Trail**

- Multiple implementation hurdles
- Requires additional feasibility analysis






### **Pedestrian Network**

- Pedestrian improvements in parts of Lindenville with major land use change
- S. Spruce and Colma Creek will see the biggest overhaul



### **Vehicle Network**

- Vehicle flow improvements along Airport Blvd and San Mateo Ave
- New street extensions break up bigger blocks
- S. Canal removed as part of creek widening
- Parking maintained on local access routes




### **Transit Network**

- SamTrans uses S. Spruce, Huntington, and Airport Blvd
- Private shuttles use Southline, S. Linden and Airport Blvd
- Less than a ¼ mile walk to a bus or shuttle stop for everyone in Lindenville



### **Proposed Cross Section - South Spruce**




### **Proposed Cross Section - South Maple (North of Victory)**




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### **Proposed Cross Section - South Maple (South of Victory)**




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### **Proposed Cross Section - South Linden (South of Colma Creek)**





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### **Proposed Cross Section - New Streets**
