SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO AND DU-ALL SAFETY

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT is made at South San Francisco, California, as of April 13, 2023 by and between THE CITY OF SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO ("City"), a municipal corporation, and DU-ALL SAFETY ("Contractor"), (sometimes referred together as the "Parties") who agree as follows:

RECITALS

A. On July 1, 2021, City and Contractor entered that certain Consulting Services Agreement ("Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to provide safety consulting services and training for the City. A true and correct copy of the Agreement and its exhibits is attached as <u>Exhibit A.</u>

B. On July 1, 2022, City and Contractor amended the Consulting Services Agreement ("First Amendment") to provide for an additional year of Consultant services. A true and correct copy of the First Amendment and its exhibits is attached as <u>Exhibit B</u>.

C. City and Contractor now desire to amend the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the promises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, City and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

- 1. All terms which are defined in the Agreement shall have the same meaning when used in this Amendment, unless specifically provided herein to the contrary.
- 2. Section 1. The June 30, 2023 end date for the term of services identified in Section 1 of the Agreement is hereby replaced with August 1, 2023.
- 3. Section 2. Section 2 of the Agreement shall be amended such that the City agrees to pay Contractor a sum not to exceed \$250,000, with the understanding that \$175,000 has already been paid to the Contractor.

All other terms, conditions and provisions in the Agreement remain in full force and effect. If there is a conflict between the terms of this Amendment and the Agreement, the terms of the Agreement will control unless specifically modified by this Amendment.
