

State Law

- The Control, Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act (AUMA) was approved by voters on November 8, 2016
- SB 94 (MAUCRSA) merged the nonmedical and medical statutory framework

Proposed Regulations for Commercial Cannabis Indoor Cultivation

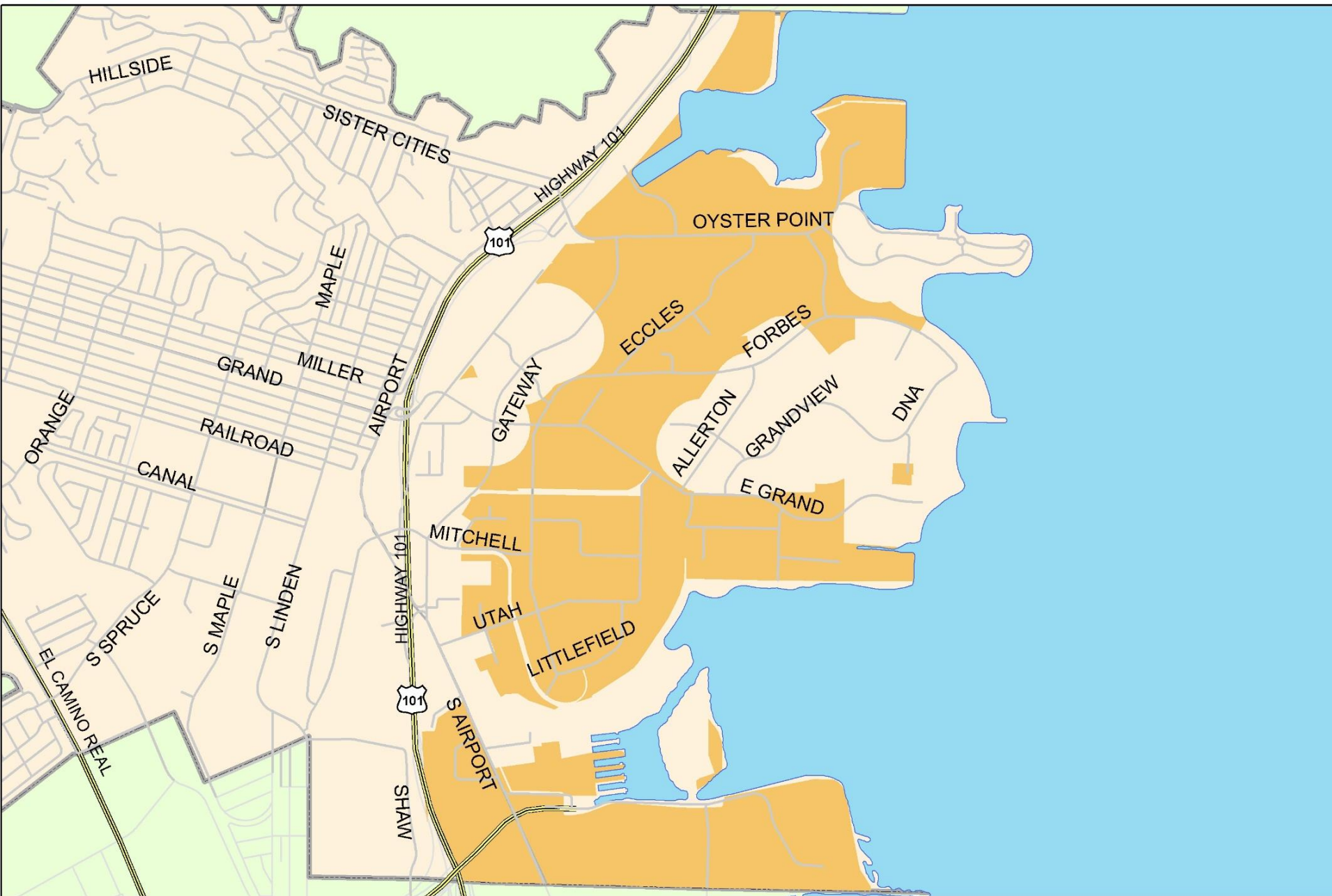
- Revises the definition of indoor cultivation to only include operations that use artificial lighting
- Introduces performance standards such as permitted zoning districts, distance requirements, and operational standards


Proposed Regulations for Commercial Cannabis Indoor Cultivation (cont.)

- Subject to Operator Permit and Conditional Use Permit process

Staff Recommendation

That the City Council adopt an ordinance amending Title 20 (“Zoning”) of the South San Francisco Municipal to regulate commercial cannabis indoor cultivation.
