Resolution authorizing the acceptance of materials and services valued at \$2,000 from the California Center for the Book to support Library participation in the 2019 Book to Action program

WHEREAS, the Library has partnered with the San Mateo County Office of Sustainability, the South San Francisco Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee, and the Parks & Recreation Department to apply for a Book to Action grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant will facilitate community learning and discovery of sustainable transportation choices; and

WHEREAS, community members will read and discuss *A Hole in the Wind: A Climate Scientist's Bicycle Journey Across the United States* by David Goodrich; and

WEREAS, the community will be invited to participate in a series of related programs including a Fixit Clinic, bike safety classes and a critical mass cycling tour; and

WHEREAS, the California Center for the Book awarded the Library copies of the book for public distribution and speakers fees valued at \$2,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of South San Francisco that the City Council hereby accepts materials and service valued at \$2,000 from the California Center for the Book to support participation in the Book to Action program.
